

Success Story of Odisha Millets Mission Semiliguda block - Koraput district












OUTCOMES: CHANGES AFTER ONE YEAR OF OMM INTERVENTION











YIELD COMPARISON AMONG BLOCK, DISTRICT AND STATE





In Semiliguda block, the yield of 11.85 quintal/hectare in 2017-18 for millets cultivated under OMM was higher than the yield of 10.98 quintal/hectare in 2016-17 for millets cultivated in baseline.


Under OMM in 2017-18, yield of millets in Semiliguda at 11.85 quintal/hectare is slightly lower than Koraput district's yield of 11.95 quintal/hectare and the state's average yield of 12.72 quintal/hectare.

METHOD WISE OUTCOME









In Semiliguda block, in 2017-18 under OMM, share of area was greater for LT (69%) while the share of produce was greater for SMI (53%). The yield from SMI at 20.4 quintal/hectare was 2.55 times greater than that from LT.
