

Success Story of Odisha Millets Mission Sinapali block - Nuapada district






















YIELD COMPARISON AMONG BLOCK, DISTRICT AND STATE





In Sinapali, the yield of 8.25 quintal/hectare in 2017-18 for millets cultivated under OMM was 2.22 times higher than the yield of 3.72 quintal/hectare in 2016-17 for millets cultivated in baseline.

Under OMM in 2017-18, yield of millets in Sinapali at 8.25 quintal/hectare is lower than Nuapada district's yield of 9.84 quintal/hectare and the state's average yield of 12.72 quintal/hectare.











SEASON WISE OUTCOME
